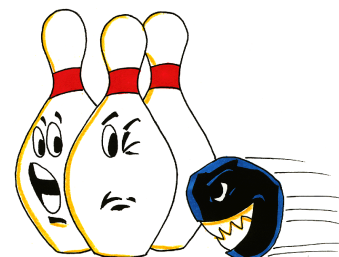

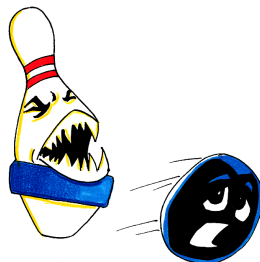

## TOURNAMENT RULES:

1. All Tonawandas USBC Youth members are eligible to enter.
2. Non-members may enter by purchasing an Association membership (\$12) or, by paying a participation fee (\$2).
3. Entries will be accepted on a first-come first-served basis. Bowlers will be notified by phone if no vacancy exists.
4. Paid entries, \$8 per bowler, **must be submitted by 2PM Saturday, March 24, 2012.**
5. **ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY FORM. INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED.**
6. Bowlers will compete in one of the following divisions:

	<u>BOYS</u>	<u>GIRLS</u>
Division A	141 avg & over	126 & over
Division B	101 – 140	101 – 125
Division C	100 & under	100 & under
7. Handicap will be 100% of 225 for all bowlers.
8. Foul detecting devices will be in operation.
9. All bowlers are responsible for the accuracy of their average. Failure to notify a tournament official of the proper average prior to the completion of the first game shall disqualify the bowler.
10. **Bowlers may not use school averages for this competition.**
11. Bowlers must use highest current USBC average as of February 18, 2011 (minimum 9 games).
12. If no current USBC average, bowler will use highest 2009-2010 USBC average (minimum 9 games).
13. If a bowler does not have a current year or 2009-2010 USBC average then the bowler will bowl scratch in Division A.
14. No re-entries allowed.
15. Bowlers are asked to report no later than **30 minutes before** their starting time.
16. All USBC Rules will be in effect.
17. Awards will be given in all divisions for first place scratch winner as well as the top three (3) series with handicap. Awards will also be given in all divisions for All Events first place scratch winner as well as the top three (3) All Events with handicap.
18. In the All Events competition twelve (12) scholarships will be awarded. Awards will be made to the boy and girl with the highest scratch total, as well as to the boy and girl with the highest total with handicap in each division.
19. All Events division will be based on division assigned for Singles competition.
20. **Bowlers must compete in all three (3) events (Team, Doubles, and Singles) to qualify for the All Events competition and scholarships.**
21. Award fees returned 100% through scholarships and awards.
22. The decision of the Tournament Director will be final in resolving all disputes or dealing with any unforeseen situations or emergencies, unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule #329.
