To be eligible for Bowler of the Year, bowler **must** be a member of an association-sanctioned Youth league and must have bowled in at least one of the following tournaments: Youth Singles, Youth Doubles, or Youth Team

* A bowler can receive credit for an achievement up to 8 times maximum in one season.
